



Emissions Categories

The GHG protocol standard categorises emissions depending on where they are generated. 7 greenhouse gases are tracked; CO₂, CH₄, N₂O, HFC, PFC, SF₆, NF₃; summarised as the equivalent amount of Carbon Dioxide that would give the same warming effect or "CO₂e".
